> **Project size:** £7million

> **Project scope:** New build headquarters campus with multiple pitch roof and brick construction reflecting the warehouses that characterise the surrounding riverside area.

> **Project details:** To complement the Petersen bricks, the architect chose EcoRight Coal Black hydraulic lime mortar with a recessed joint.

The new headquarters of Tombola has modern and technologically advanced open-plan offices on the first and second floors, and a three-storey-high atrium which will flood natural light throughout the glazed building. The ground floor has a reception area, bistro and gym for employees, with bleacher-style stairs leading to the upper floors.

The building also boasts a diverse range of informal training / presentation suites with the latest AV / video conferencing technology.

The design philosophy was to create an open, light and airy environment that will encourage creative thinking and open, informal communications.

The use of bricks to create the embossed Tombola logo in the main atrium adds a stylish finish to this modern building that has more than a passing nod to the industrial, riverside location in which it resides.
