> Project size: A contemporary, new build consisting of two hexagonal towers.

> Project scope: A contemporary new build consisting of two hexagonal towers sat between Shoreditch Park and Regent's Canal. The towers house luxury apartments and penthouses with wrap-around balconies and roof terraces and ground floor café.

> Project details: EcoRight was invited to match brickwork to achieve a uniform colour blend between brick and mortar. Significantly the domed area movement joints had to be avoided. The architect chose a hydraulic lime mortar option and EcoRight developed two bespoke colours of Sierra Red and Urban Slate to achieve the desired aesthetic.
